Arizona Newspaper Hall of Fame Nomination Guidelines

PURPOSE

To provide appropriate recognition of Arizona newspaper men and women who have made a lifetime of achievement and service to the newspaper industry.

CRITERIA

The following criteria are guidelines. The Arizona Newspaper Hall of Fame Committee may from time to time waive certain aspects of these criteria.

- ◆ Nominees, living or deceased, must have worked in their career for at least 20 years, with at least 15 of those years in journalism in Arizona.
- ◆ Nominees should have made a significant contribution to newspapering, their communities and/or Arizona.
- ◆ Nominees can be anyone in the newspaper business: publisher, advertising manager or director, editors, reporters, public affairs, circulation, production.
- ◆ Selections for the Hall of Fame may be limited each year based on the review of the Hall of Fame Committee. Nominations in and of themselves are not a guarantee of acceptance in the Hall of Fame. Nominations may also be held at the discretion of the Hall of Fame committee for reconsiderations in subsequent years if they are not selected in the year in which they are nominated.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – PICTURES, BIOGRAPHY NEEDED

If the Hall of Fame Committee and Board of Directors accept the nomination, a portrait of the nominee, and one or two pictures of them in a work setting in their Arizona newspaper(s) are required. A more in-depth biography also will be needed. We ask the nominator to help secure these.

DEADLINE

Nominations must be submitted no later than July 25, 2008. All nominations will be kept confidential. Send the nomination form to the Arizona Newspapers Association, 1001 N. Central Ave., Suite 670, Phoenix, AZ 85004-1947.

WHO CAN MAKE A NOMINATION?

Anyone is eligible to make a nomination. You may nominate more than one person.
