## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Applicant must be a full-time journalism student at ASU, UA, or NAU at the time of applying. Student must have completed at least one term and have one term remaining before graduation.
- Students must have demonstrated an interest in pursuing a career in the newspaper industry including journalism, photography, arts and graphics, online, advertising or marketing.
- Applicant should have a minimum cumulative grade average of 3.0.
- Employees of Arizona Newspapers Foundation, Inc. or Arizona Newspapers Association, Inc. or members of their immediate families are not eligible for awards.

## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

A panel of ANF board members will evaluate all applications. Candidates will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Essay
- Published Work
- Current Resume
- Transcript
- Letters of Recommendation (one must be from a professor)

## **ESSAY**

Please provide a 1,000 to 1,500-word essay explaining your interest in the newspaper business. Please include your educational goals and how they relate to your career objectives.

## **PUBLISHED WORK**

Must include at least one, but up to six samples of published work. Tear sheets preferred but not necessary. Must include publication name and date published. Please include full URL with online samples.

## **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS REQUESTED**

**Resume** – Include scholastic honors, student activities, work experience and community service

**Transcript(s)** – Two letters of recommendation (one from teacher or advisor)

**Headshot Photograph** – Photo will be required if a scholarship is awarded
